## a) **PSERN** Update

Scott Hatfield reports that 11 of the 12 partners have signed the ILA agreement. King County has yet to pass the ILA agreement. It will be presented to their full council on the 29<sup>th</sup>. After the Notice to Proceed, PSERN will begin the design phase of the project. Groundbreaking will likely not begin until next spring.

#### b) Rebanding

Scott Hatfield reports new combiner installations have been completed. The retune will be from 6/29-7/2 and will affect service. One channel must be retuned across all 4 simulcasts at the same time which will decrease the capacity of the system. This will increase the likelihood of busy bonks. All dispatch centers and agencies will be advised of this information. There is the potential for busy bonks, but it is unlikely for users not to be able to get through. Remind users to not keep hitting the button after receiving a busy bonk but instead keep the button depressed in order to stay in queue.

After the conclusion of this retune, there will be a 2 month break from rebanding as the other regional partners undergo their retunes. Following this will be the second touch of all the radios via depots similar to the first touch. It is the goal of EPSCA to be done with rebanding at the end of this year.
