5. <u>Reports</u>

a) Rebanding Update

Scott Hatfield reports that all subscriber radios have been rebanded or re-tuned. EPSCA is still waiting for some equipment for the NORCOM recording radios in order to begin the rebanding of the NORCOM control station radios. This will delay us until mid-November, which due to uncertain weather conditions, could delay rebanding of the infrastructure.

This delay will not impact the end user.

b) Diagnostics Box Results

Scott Hatfield reports that the diagnostics box is a regionally owned piece of equipment that measures the frequency and output of a radio as it affiliates with a site. He handed out a report containing a list of the radios that failed at the North Seattle site. The number of radios that failed is a vast improvement over previous tests. Scott will send an electronic copy to the Operations Committee for dissemination in order to tune up the failing radios.

6. <u>Action Items</u>

a) Maintenance Contract Renewal

Scott Hatfield presents a 2 year maintenance contract renewal with Motorola to continue the current contract. Included is a system audit by a Motorola system technician to ensure that our tenured technician is not accidentally missing anything. There has been no pricing difference for several years. Mark Risen motioned to recommend to the Executive Board to approve the extension of this maintenance contract, it was seconded by Nick Seibert and carried 6-0.
